



Unit Equipment

Dear Heads of Contingents,

with this circular we present you some key information about the unit site and equipment together with some tips about what to take (and what not to take) for the European Jamboree 2020.

Unit site

Each unit (4 patrols – 36 Scouts and Guides together with their 4 Adult Patrol Leaders) will get a surface of 540 m² (20m x 27m).

Please note that:

- ▶ that although total surface remain unchanged dimensions were slightly updated, comparing to previous communication, due to the bigger total number of the European Jamboree participants.

Unit equipment

Each unit will get following equipment that will allow them to camp and cook during the Jamboree:

What to take

Please note that:

- ▶ tents and personal equipment like mattress, sleeping bags or cutlery and crockery will not be provided. While selecting tents (or informing your participants what kind of tents they should bring) make sure they are waterproof and fit in the area of the unit site..

Make sure that your participants and IST will take with them:

- ▶ Waterproof jackets
- ▶ Warmer clothes
- ▶ Mosquito repellent
- ▶ Swimming suit
- ▶ Sunscreen
- ▶ Good walking shoes (preferably waterproof as well)
- ▶ Water bottle (container)
- ▶ Small bag pack
- ▶ Bags or lunchbox to pack lunches prepared by themselves in the morning
- ▶ Sun hat
- ▶ Flashlight
- ▶ Recommended: solar charges for mobiles and other electronic equipment; hand sanitizer

What not to take

Please note that:

- ▶ you are not allowed to bring to the Jamboree knives with blades longer than 10 cm. It's also recommended not to bring valuables that might get lost or stolen..

Unit First Aid Kit and Medication

It is recommended that each unit takes Unit First Aid Kit. This will be valuable both during the Jamboree as well as during the pre- and post-Jamboree activities and travels.

Make sure as well that each participant has his or her needed medication in properly labelled containers in a quantity sufficient to last through the Jamboree including travel (plus 3 days' additional medication for unexpected situations – like e.g. travel delays). Be sure to verify that any emergency supplies (asthma inhalers, diabetic medications, EpiPens, etc.) are with the participant and that you or someone on your adult leadership team knows how and when to use them.

The medical staff recommends that anyone who uses corrective lenses (eyeglasses or contacts) bring also a copy of their current prescription with them. This will come in very handy if their glasses or contacts are misplaced, lost, or broken.
