Dear Heads of Contingents,

This Circular is to provide you with information about the key dates and organizational info connected with the European Jamboree 2020 arrivals and departures period. Please find details below.

Participants and IST arriving by plane, train or ferry to one of the official entry points will be provided with transport by Jamboree buses or trains to the **Check-In Centre at Amber Expo** and then to the campsite.

Participants traveling by private coaches should first check-in at **Amber Expo**.

Transportation form

In March 2020 Transportation Forms will be released – a “collective” one for Contingents to provide data for participants and an individual one for IST members. **Deadline for filling in the forms will be in May 2020.**

Jamboree Buses during the arrival and departure periods will run according to the schedule based on Contingents declarations of the timings of their arrival and departure. In the Transportation Form we will ask Contingents to provide arrival time to a relevant entry point and departure time from the relevant entry point. On this basis, we will plan the schedule for Jamboree Buses schedule (whilst considering the necessary time reserves).

Filling in the Transportation Form is obligatory as well for Contingents arriving/departing with their own buses, as these buses will be allowed to enter/exit the site at the time brackets specified in the schedule that will be prepared based on the received Transportation Forms.

Arrivals

Jamboree Buses during the IST and participants arrivals will operate based on the information received in the Transportation Forms.

The Jamboree Organisation will provide services in the following timeframe:

	First Jamboree Bus from Entry Points	Last Jamboree Bus from Entry Points
IST Arrivals	24 th July 2020 09:00	25 th July 2020 23:59
Participants Arrivals	27 th July 2020 00:01	28 th July 2020 15:00

Please note that

- ▶ Participants must arrive in full patrols together with their Adult Patrol Leader.
- ▶ Unattended participants will not be registered and will not be allowed on site.
- ▶ IST (apart from the Pre-event IST and Food Houses staff - PRE-FIN-01) will not be allowed on-site before **24th July 2019 09:00**.
- ▶ We strongly encourage all Contingents to make sure their IST will arrive on **25th July 2020** (or earlier), so they will not miss IST trainings and job inductions. Later arrivals should be exceptional and accepted only in highly justifiable situations.
- ▶ IST arriving with the Contingents will be allowed to use Jamboree buses.
- ▶ First meal for IST is dinner on **25th July 2019**. IST arriving earlier must secure their own food (using for example a commercial supermarket that will be already operating on site from **20th July 2020**).
- ▶ First meal for participants is dinner on the **27th July 2020**.

Departures

Jamboree Buses during the IST and participants departures will operate based on the information received in the Transportation Forms.

The Jamboree Organisation will provide services in the following timeframe:

Participants Departure	7 th August 2020 00:01	7 th August 2020 23:59
IST Departure	8 th August 2020 00:01	8 th August 2020 20:00

Please note that

- ▶ All exit points are the same as entry points – we will provide shuttle buses only to: Gdansk Lech Wałęsa International Airport, Gdansk Główny railway station, Gdynia ferry terminal and Amber Expo.
- ▶ All IST (except from Post-Event IST helping in disassembly of the EJ2020 site and Food Houses staff - PRE-FIN-01) must leave the site the latest on **8th August 2020**.
- ▶ Last meal for participants is breakfast on the **7th August 2020**.
- ▶ Last meal for IST is lunch on **8th August 2020**.
- ▶ Food markets for participants operate till **7th August 2020 12:00**.

Amber Expo check-in centre

Arrival Period

Amber Expo Check-In Centre will be open on **24th July 2020 09:00** and will be operating 24/7 till **28th July 2020 23:59**.

During the European Jamboree

Starting from **29th July 2020** till **6th August 2020** Amber Expo Check-In Centre will be operating every day from 08:00 till 18:00.

All persons willing to enter the site (including Day Visitors, Contingents' Guests, Media) must first register at Amber Expo Check-In Centre before going on site using Jamboree shuttle buses (please see below).

Earlier arrivals and later departures

- ▶ CMT members and Food Houses staff - PRE-FIN-01 are allowed on site from **20th July 2020 09:00**.
- ▶ Arrivals of Pre-event IST building the site will be individually agreed according to their specific roles.
- ▶ For all people arriving before the opening of the Amber Expo Check-In Centre, an on-site check-in point at the Jamboree Gate will be organized. Medical help for Contingent members present on site from **20th July 2020** will be provided. No meals will be provided, but commercial supermarket will be already operating starting from **20th July 2020**.
- ▶ CMT members and Food Houses staff - PRE-FIN-01 must leave the site the latest on **9th August 2020 23.59**.

Jamboree shuttle buses

Jamboree shuttle buses will run in the loop Gdańsk Główny railway station – Amber Expo – Camp site – Gdańsk Główny railway station. Jamboree shuttle buses will operate from **24th July 2020 19:00** till **8th August 2020 20:00**. The exact timetable will be provided at the later date.

Cargo

It will be possible for the Contingents to ship goods (equipment and materials) to the Jamboree site prior to the European Jamboree. Contingents will need to provide the Jamboree organizers with information in advance, including the estimated time of arrival of shipped goods and a detailed description of the contents.

Cargo (EUR-containers and EUR-pallets) are allowed on site from **20th July 2020** to **14th August 2020**. Collars for EUR-pallets are required up to the loading high. Shipments must be protected against weather conditions as they will be stored outdoors.
