



Connecting Experience Collection Challenge

AMOUNT OF PEOPLE

TIME

2 – 4 WEEKS

OBJECTIVE

To do something to help people in poverty in their community with what the current needs are.

MATERIAL

Boxes/containers to collect things in, paper, markers



Instructions

Have participants choose a local charity such as a foodbank, women's shelter or homeless aid. If there are no such charities in their area, they could set up a space in their meeting hall or town centre where people in need can access what they've collected.

Once they've chosen a group, get in contact to find out what materials the charity needs or see what the community is in need of which you can help with.

Choose places in their area where people gather and set up collection points, these could be in your meeting place, schools, markets, anywhere that has a lot of people.

Have participants create posters or social media posts to encourage people to make donations at one of their collection points.

Combine everything and donate it to their chosen charity.

Raise awareness of the charity after they complete their collection challenge, encourage people to make donations whenever they can, not just during the event.
